- Started with discovery around a real business problem: a street-food operator needed to record orders, reconcile cash and local-POS payments and manage ledgers with unreliable electricity and no receipt printer.
- Mapped founder and staff workflows and defined a tablet-first MVP using an AI-assisted product-development workflow; introduced digital QR receipts, sales and ledger tracking, owner dashboards, discounts and customer loyalty.
- Added AI-assisted performance insights so the owner could ask questions about business performance and receive decision-support suggestions.
- Evolved the architecture and product model to support multiple tenants, staff, outlets and free/subscription tiers after interest from other business owners.
- **Product-management evidence:** contextual discovery, constraints, MVP definition, prioritisation, business-model evolution, platform thinking and commercialisation.

- Designed after identifying a coordination problem during Smart Food Cities fieldwork: the team needed to know which businesses had been visited, delivered to, refused, required a return or needed follow-up.
- Designed the workflow around a dataset of 597 food businesses with search by business, street or postcode, status filters, directions, progress reporting and offline capability.
- Prioritised rapid status updates and operational visibility so field activity could be planned without paper notes or continuous connectivity.
- **Product-management evidence:** internal-tool discovery, frontline workflow design, offline-first trade-offs, operational UX and rapid problem-to-product delivery.

- Final-year project addressing food waste, food insecurity, cold-chain safety, donor liability, traceability and inefficient last-mile routing across multiple stakeholders.
- Designed role-based experiences for donors, drivers, recipients and administrators and integrated a React presentation layer, FastAPI orchestration, PPO reinforcement learning, simulated IoT telemetry and a SHA-256 cryptographic audit layer.
- Built a Cambridge digital-twin simulation using OSMnx and defined measurable success criteria around waste diversion, breach recovery and trust/audit events.
- Results: recovered 27 of 30 thermal breaches; 98.0% simulated waste-diversion rate versus an 80.0% static-routing baseline; cryptographic hashes for 150 simulated transactions. Awarded 87%.
- **Product-management evidence:** stakeholder mapping, platform gap analysis, technical trade-offs, experimentation, risk and safety thinking, success metrics and future roadmap.
